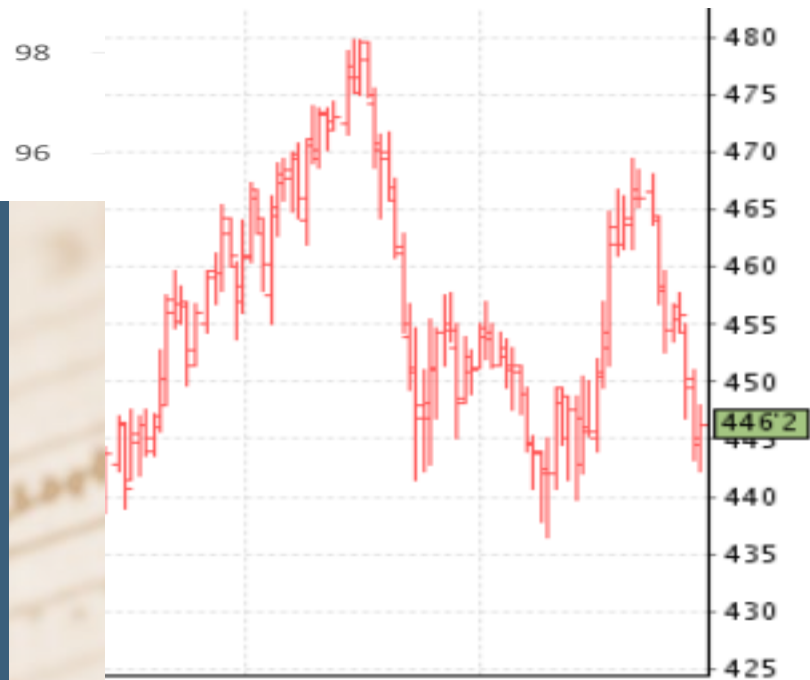

Chicago December Corn Futures, 2000-2022

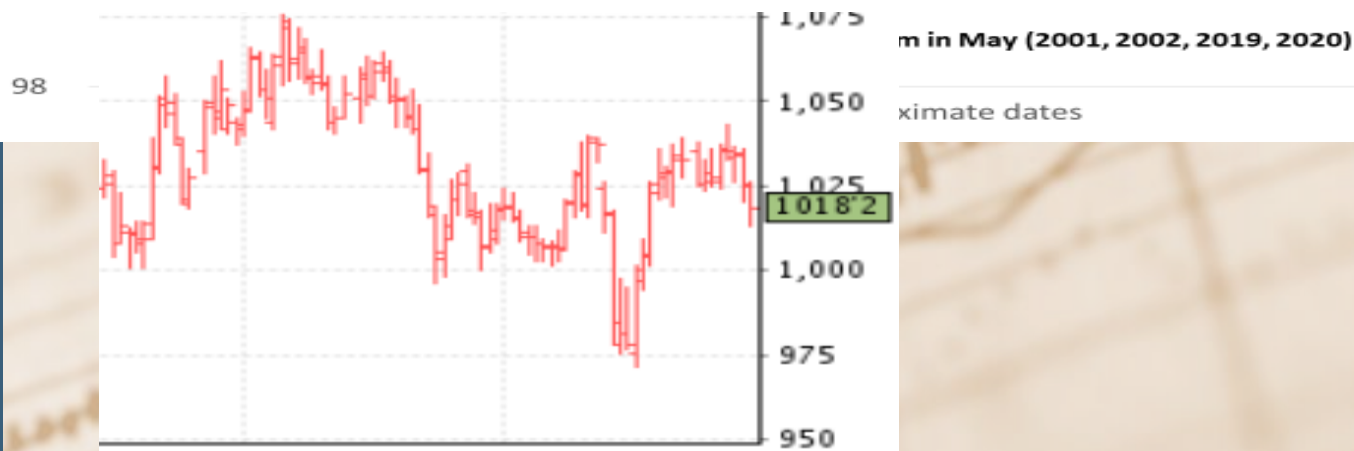

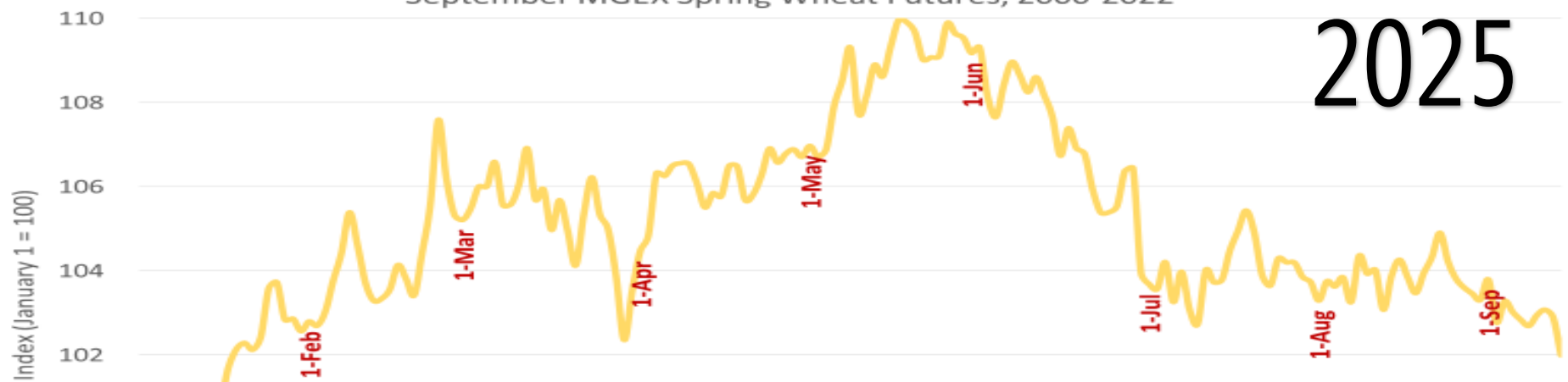

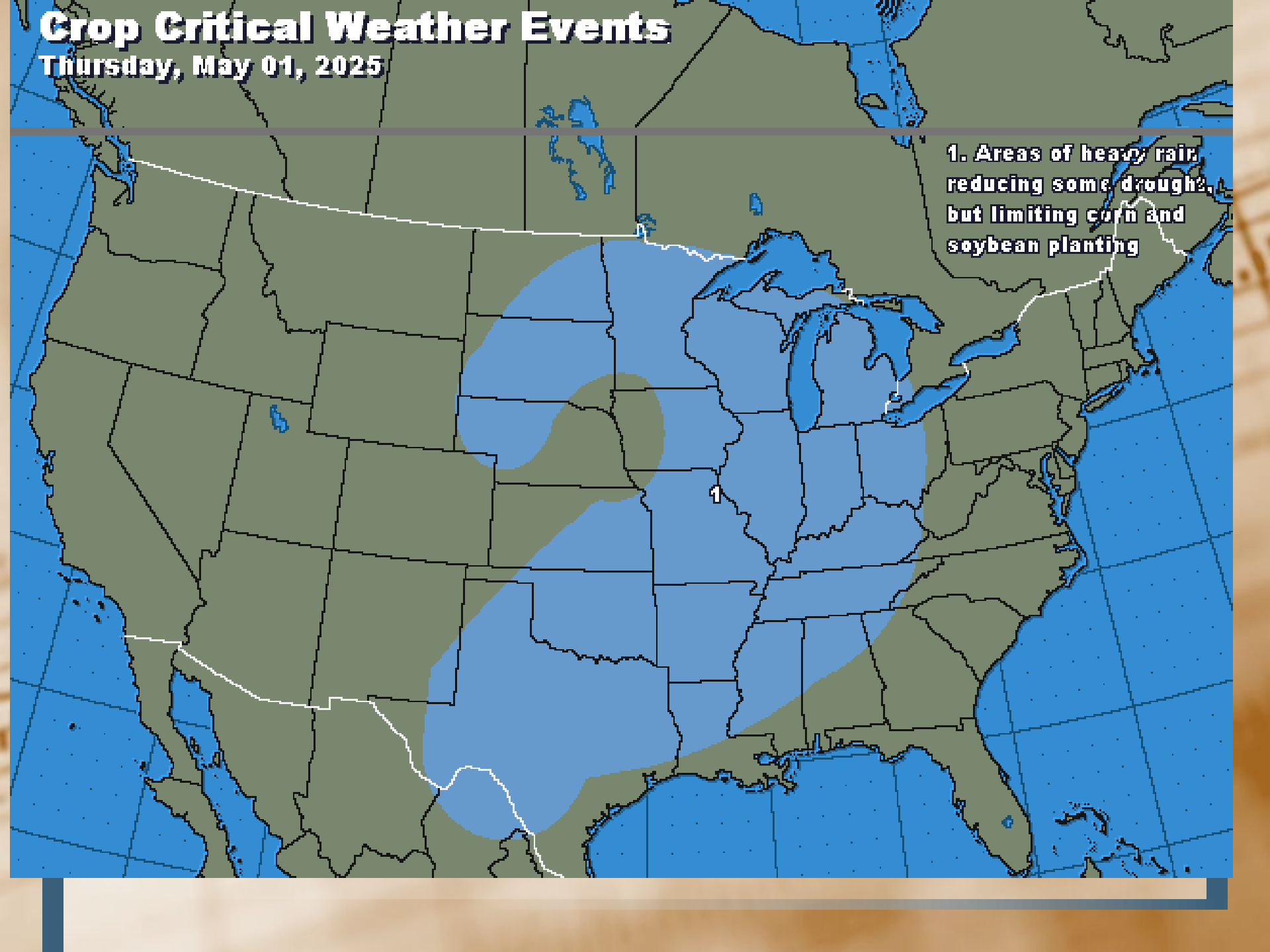

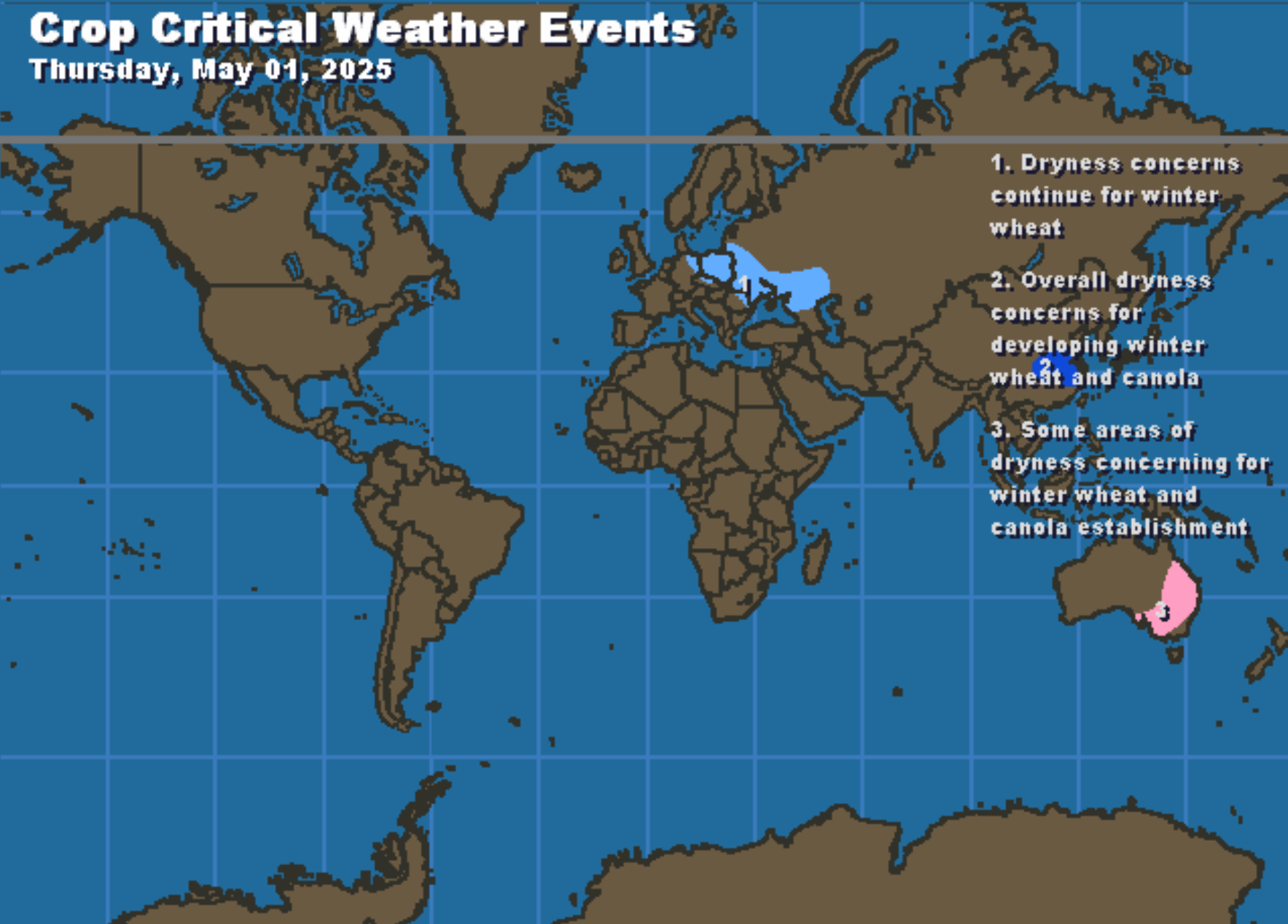

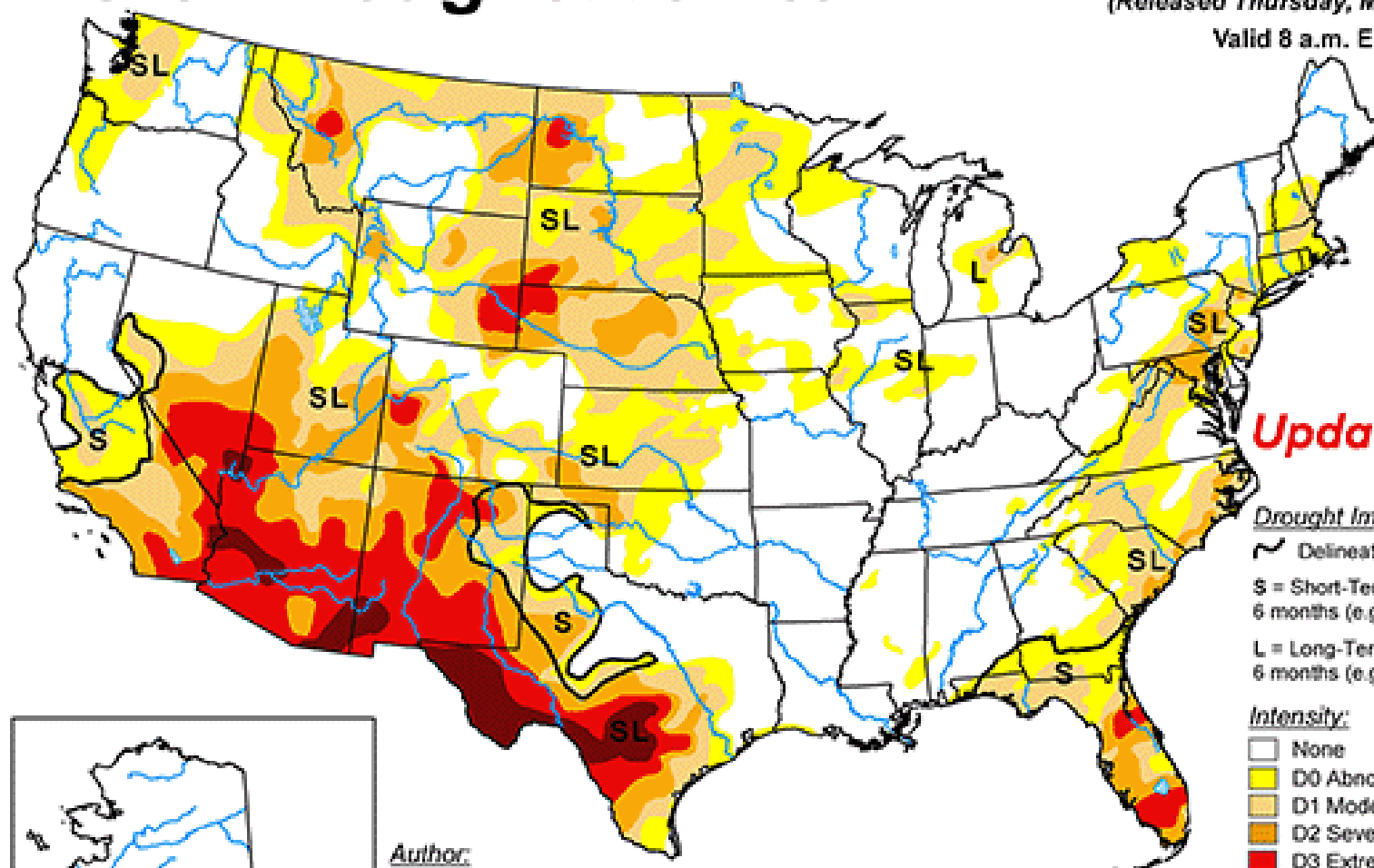

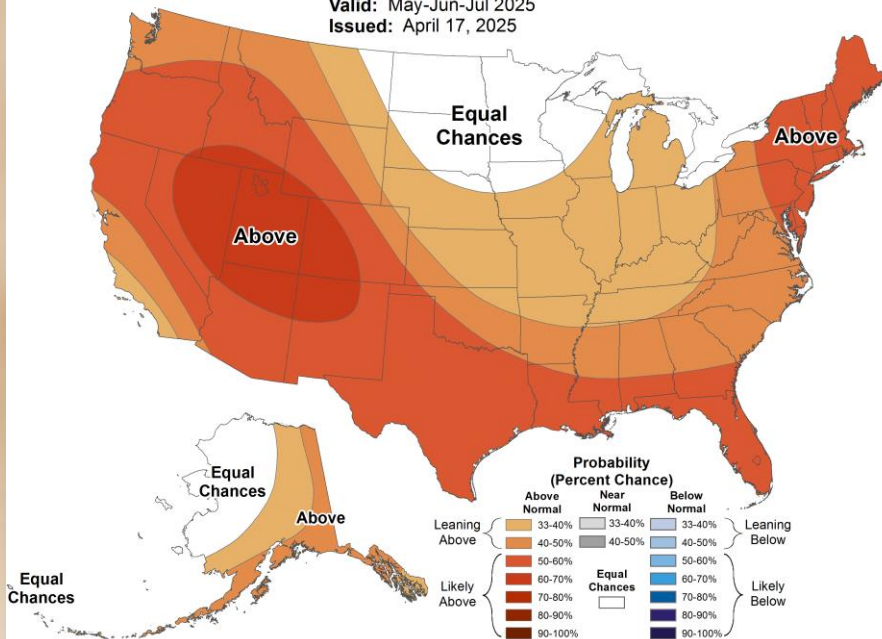




Seasonal Temperature Outlook



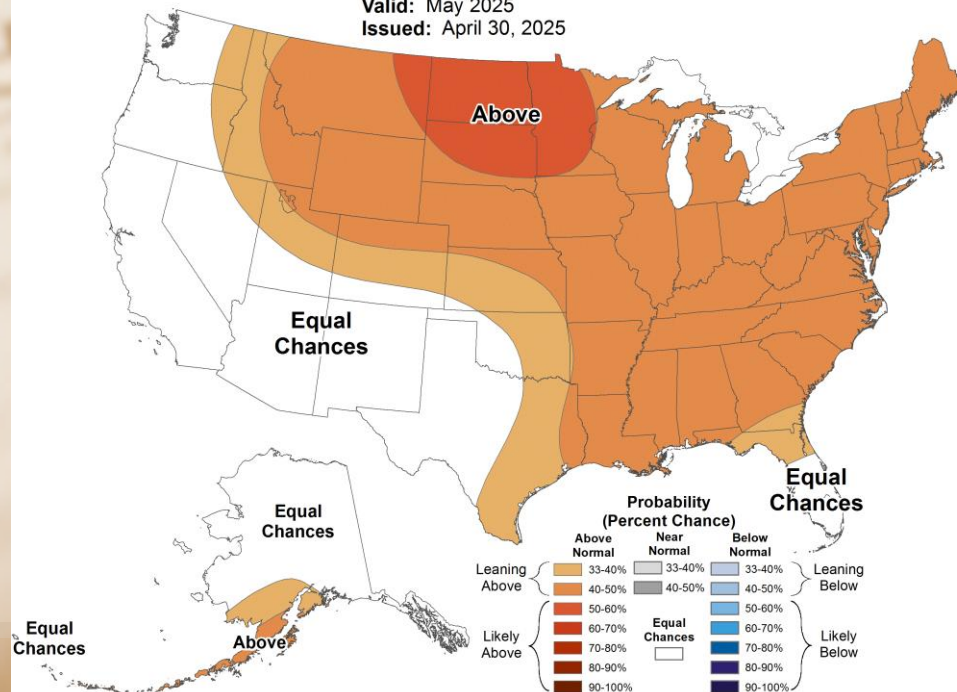

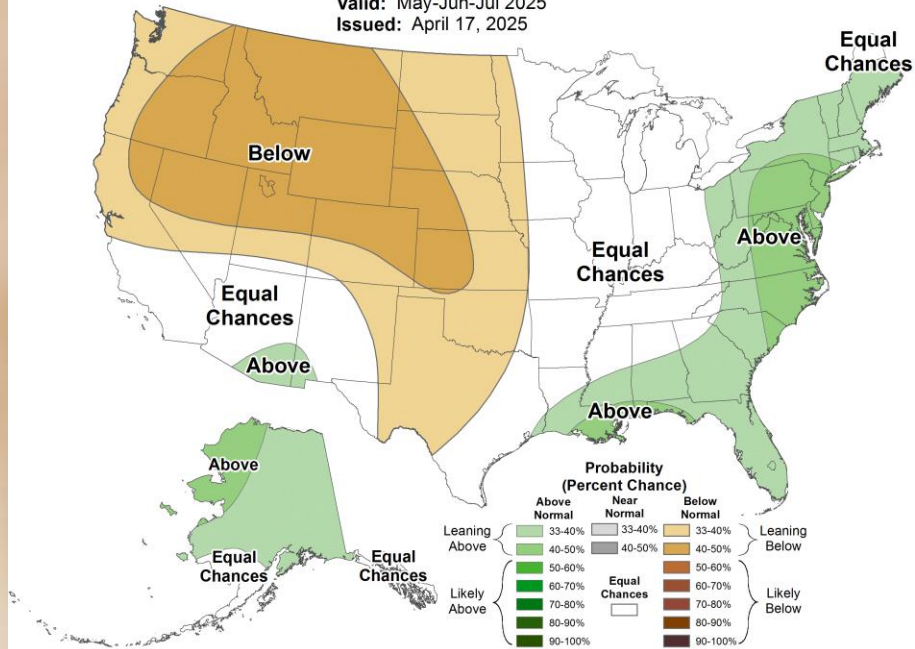




Seasonal Precipitation Outlook



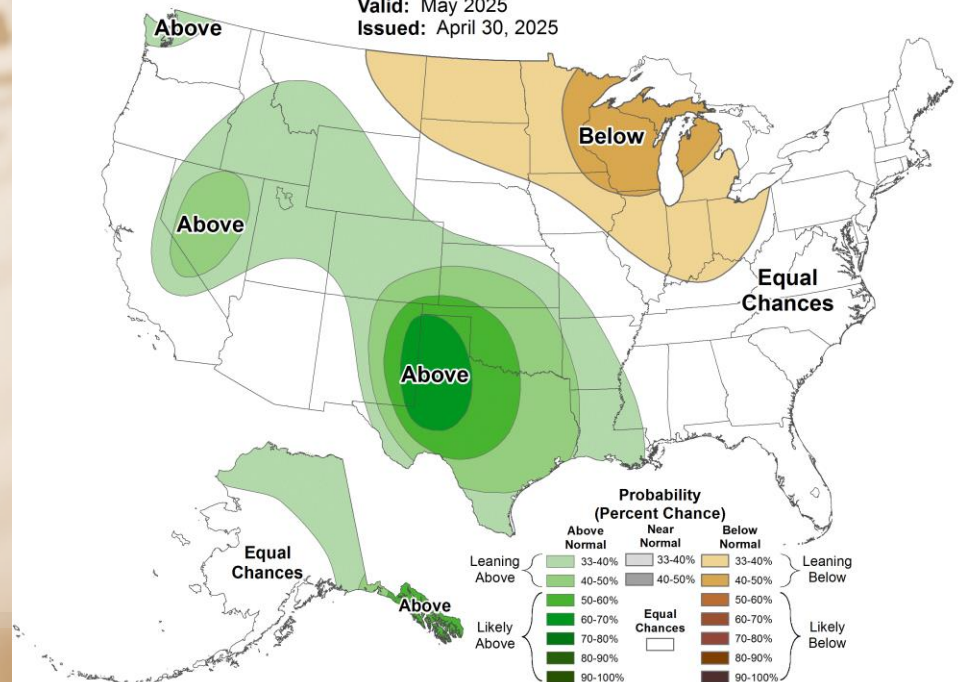

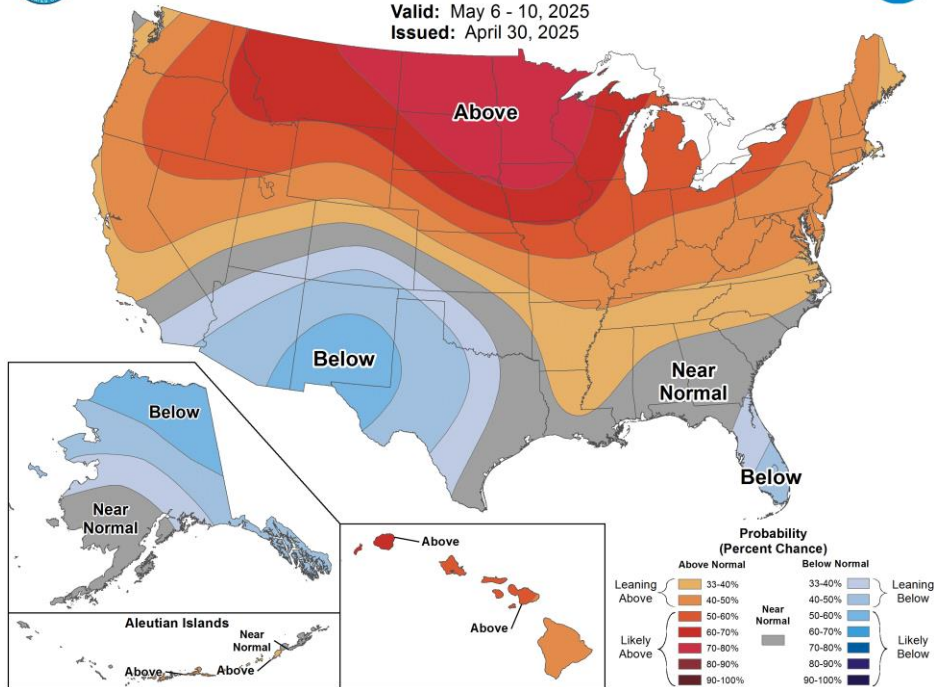




6-10 Day Temperature Outlook



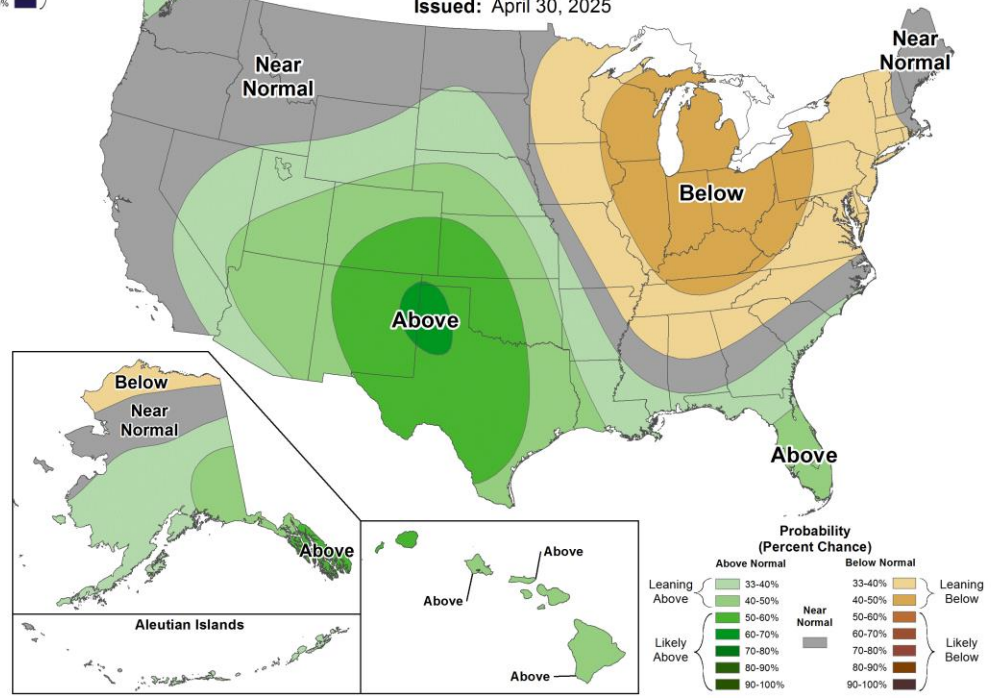

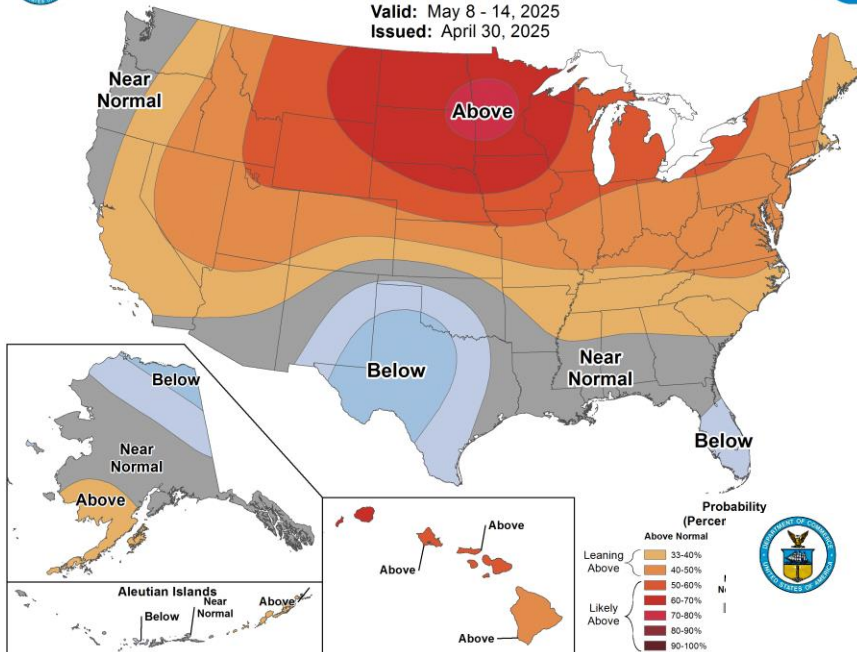




8-14 Day Temperature Outlook



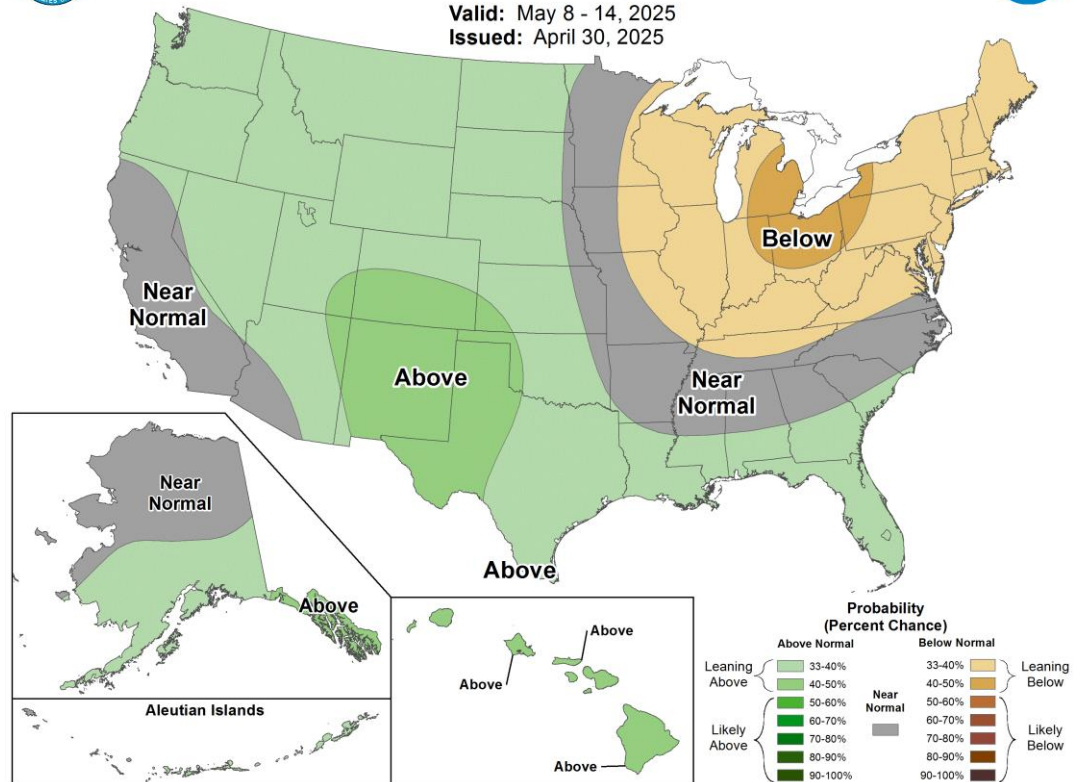

- General: Current General Market Movers
- Concerns in market over economic slowdown. Oil markets are factoring in reduced demand.
- Grain markets have strong demand, tightening ending stocks, weather and trade relations/tariffs. Likely to keep market volatility high.
- Planting progress and crop reports will be watched closely-currently very positive for growing crops.

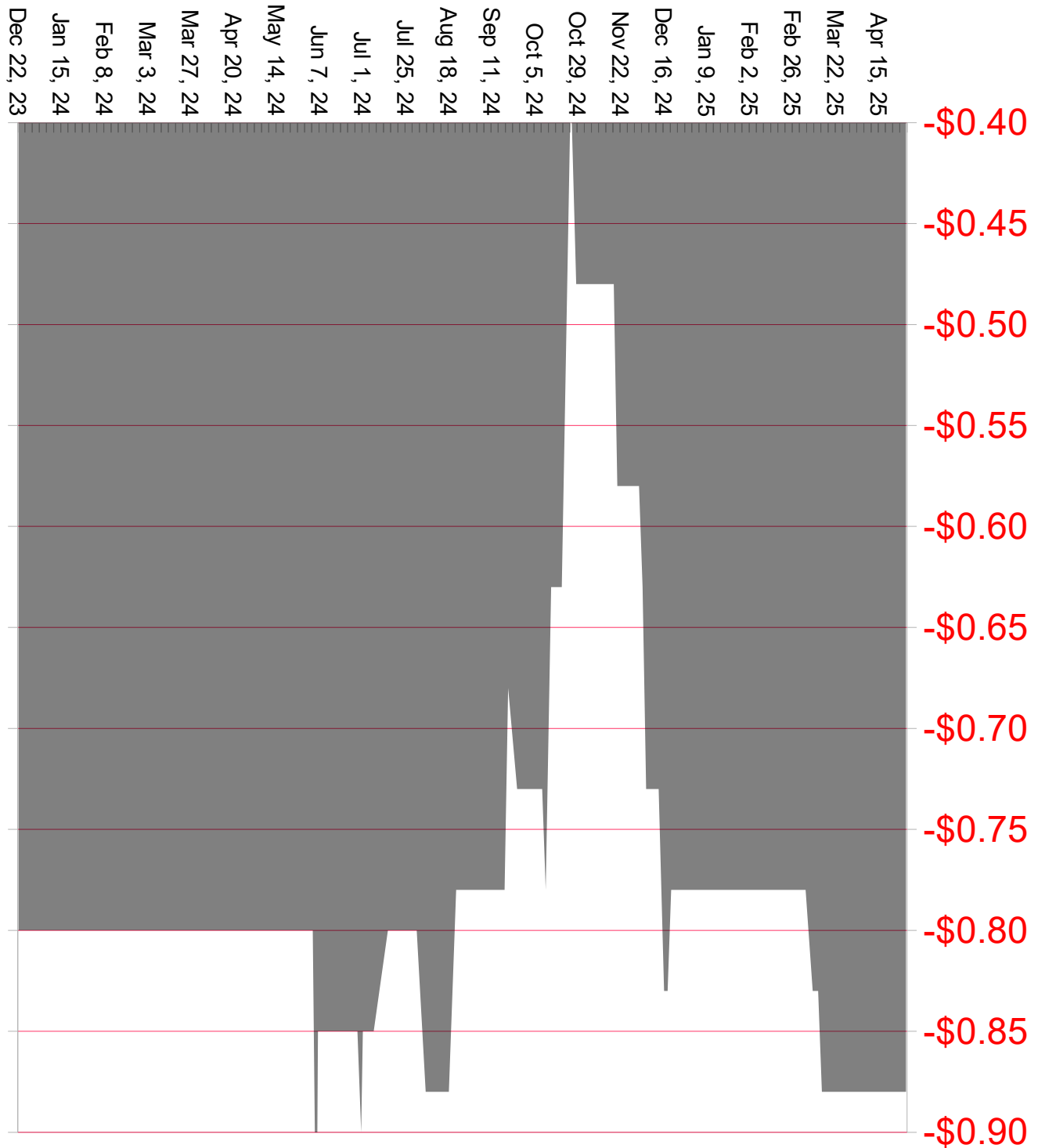

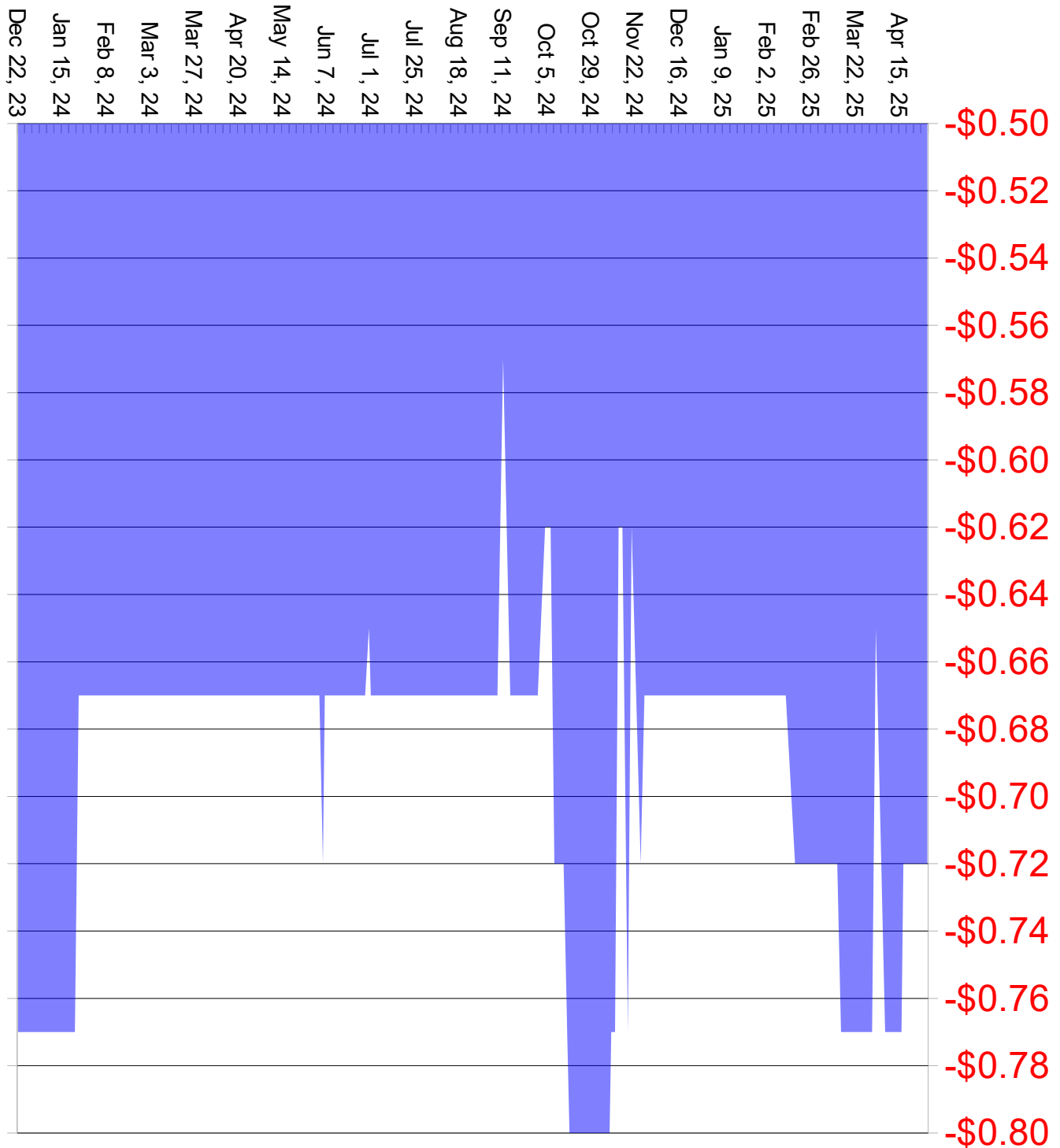
2024 Final Corn Breakeven \$4.24



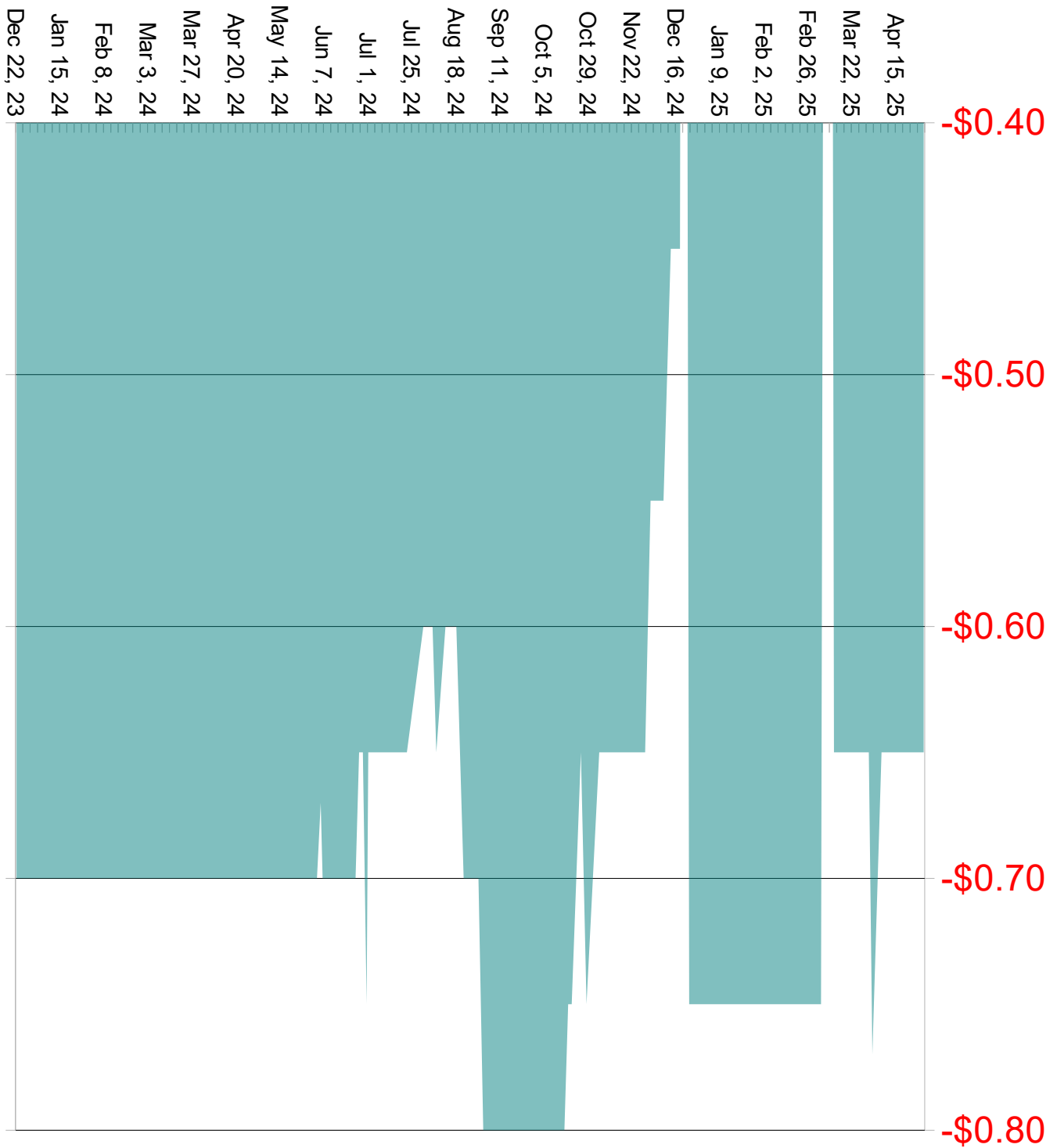
