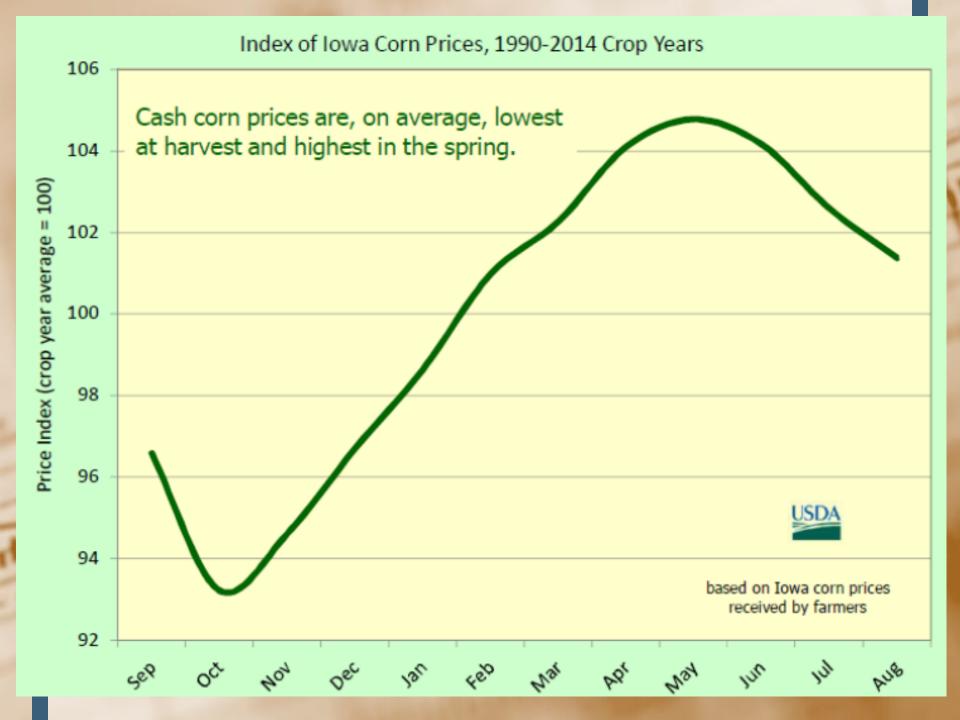

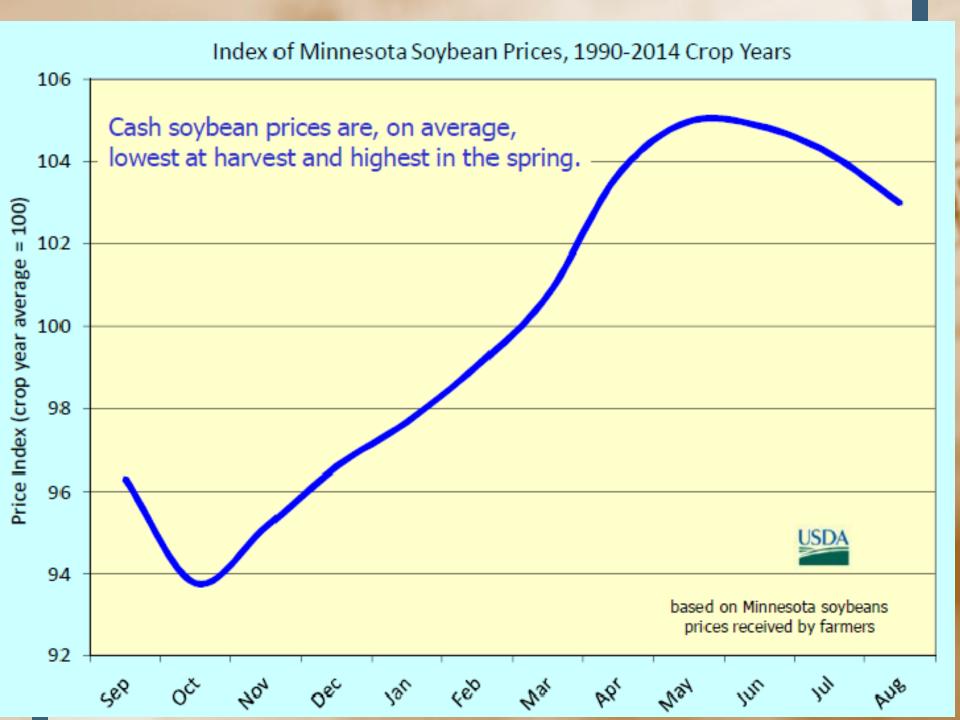
WHAT IS A PENNANT PATTERN?

A Pennant pattern is a continuation chart pattern, seen when a security experiences a large upward or downward movement, followed by a brief consolidation, before continuing to move in the same direction. The pattern looks like a small symmetrical triangle called a Pennant, which is made up of numerous <u>forex candlesticks</u>. Depending on the direction of the movement, Pennant patterns are usually described as being bearish or bullish.

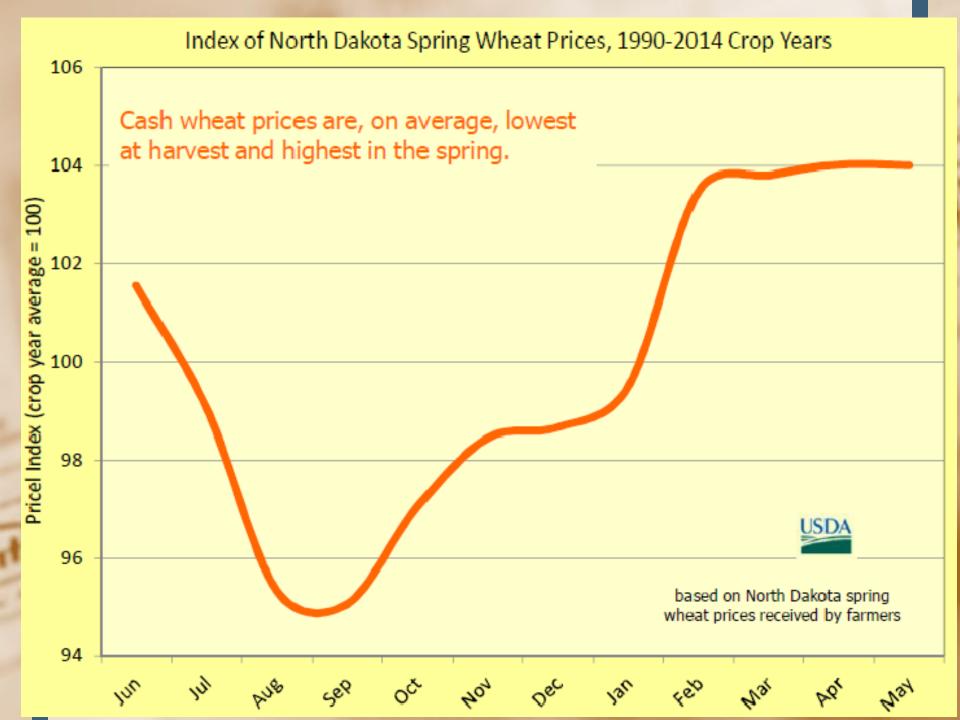




- General- The July WASDE report was as expected with no changes for Soybean and Corn Yields, but just the updated acres from the Acreage Report. Most traders don't believe the yields, an interesting dynamic is the need for the record yields to make sure we don't have tighter ending stocks next year than we have now. Weather will be the main market mover in the coming months, especially in Northern Plains and Upper Midwest.
- July will most likely see similar volatility as June/May/April.
 There is still a need for all acres and yield estimates to be correct just to keep ending stocks at levels slightly above very tight for soybeans and tight for corn.

Corn- Even with some timely rains hitting parts of SD and lowa today, the hot and dry forecast is concerning as the crop enters pollination. Some forecasters are already pointing to this weather pattern continuing through August and maybe into September. The corn market is focused on yield. Dec support at \$5.17, resistance at \$6.45

Soybeans- How can we reach a record yield when major states are well behind historical crop conditions that created the last record yield? Still, it is worth noting that the November soybean chart is creating a pennant formation. We mentioned this same formation happening in the new crop corn contract. This is a continuation pattern, which if true, would continue to push futures higher. However, before a breakout to the upside, we will likely experience lower highs and higher lows to complete the formation. Nov support \$13.03 and resistance at \$14.45

 Wheat- Mpls has pushed to new contract highs this week, how high can we go may depend on actual yield numbers. Only rated 16% GtoE on last report and more heat and lack of moisture in coming weeks. Sept Support at \$6.95, Resistance at \$8.65


10 year Wheat Cash Price






